*In many instances, the Priory was responsible for providing a priest to conduct services and it may also have had responsibility for upkeep of part of the building and supplying books and candles for use during services.*

*In return, the patron saints of local churches were remembered on their Saint's Day by processions and services at the Priory; for example, the patron saint of St Genny's held special significance and it has been speculated that a relic of the Saint was held at the Priory. St Genny's annual Saint's Day was held on the 19<sup>th</sup> July.*
